Paint and Paint Solvents

Policy Statement

In order to provide a safe environment for our employees and patrons, this policy outlines the proper procedures for the clean up and disposal of paint and paint supplies.

- 1. Use disposable brushes, rollers, buckets, and paint trays whenever possible to avoid the use of any paint thinner or cleaners.
- 2. Allow brushes, rollers, rags, etc. which have been soiled with paint to dry before disposing of in dumpsters.
- 3. Do not clean out brushes, rollers, paint buckets, trays, etc. over any storm drain or on any park grounds.
- 4. If solvent is used to clean painting equipment all soiled solvent must be returned to approved container and re-used. (Use approved cleaners only marked for this purpose.)
- 5. Any rags used to clean up with solvent must be allowed to completely dry before being discarded in dumpster.
- 6. Any used paint solvent to be disposed of must be sent to a hazardous waste disposal company for legal disposal.

Latex Paints and Cleaners

1. Brushes and painting equipment must be cleaned with soap and water only.

2. Do not clean brushes, rollers, etc. over any storm drains or on any outside park grounds.
