Safety Shoe Policy

Policy Statement

This policy is a part of the Recreation Commission's PPE program to require protective footwear for Property Management Staff.

The Richland County Recreation Commission requires Property Management Staff to wear safety shoes (Personal Protective Equipment-PPE).

In the event these shoes are provided by the Recreation Commission Property Management staff will be given a selection of shoes to choose from an approved vendor/s. In the event the Commission budget does not permit the purchase of safety shoes staff will still be required to purchase and wear safety shoes while on duty. All shoes must be American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standard F2413-05 certified.

All safety shoes must meet the requirements as set forth by the Richland County Recreation Commission. Furthermore, safety shoes will be considered a part of the Property Management required uniform.

Note: Any employee requesting more than one pair of safety shoes per budget year may purchase an additional set, at his/her expense. These shoes must meet all RCRC safety requirements.
