## LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

We are pleased to present our Annual Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 ("The Budget") of the Richland County Recreation Commission. Our recommendations reflect the priorities set by our Executive Leadership team, inleuding our Executive Director and Deputy Directors, and are based on a thorough review of our current financial status, revenue trends, and economic data. The budget demonstrates our commitment to provide evidence based recreational programming, safe and accessible facilities, and customer service excellence.

#### The budget includes:

- Ongoing upgrades and repairs to our facilities to improve accessibility and functionality
- Increased opportunities for programming focused on health and wellness, social equity, and conservation
- Adequate staffing to effectively serve the citizens of Richland County

### **ABOUT THE BUDGET PROCESS**

The Fiscal Year 2025 Budget process was refined through an update of the Commission's budget structure which has been presented monthly at our Board meetings by our Deputy Director of Finance. Richland County Recreation Commission maintains a transparent budget process to ensure the proper allocation of funds.

Internally, the process begins with the distribution of budget templates to each division for review and discussion. In addition, budget presentations are given to Commission personnel by the Finance Department. The budget presentations provide Commission staff with key information about the elements of budgeting and the budget process and assist each division in developing budget recommendations for the coming year.

After review, each division submits their budget recommendations to senior management and direction is provided to staff for any changes that need to be made or reviewed. When all revisions and reviews are complete, the budget is presented to the Board of Commissioners for consideration. The proposed budget is then submitted to the Richland County Council for review and approval.

The Commission's budget goes through three budget ordinance readings at scheduled Richland County Council meetings. A public hearing is also held where Richland County citizens are invited to make comments for or against the ordinance. Once the budget is approved, final budget books are printed and distributed to senior management and published to the Commission's website. The new budget takes effect July 1st of each year.

Throughout this meticulous process, our team keeps our mission in mind: we are committed to enriching lives and connecting communities through diverse recreation opportunities.

The Richland County Recreation Commission would like to thank Richland County Council for their consideration of our presentations, and approval of the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget.


